Today the children will have come home with the name of the country their class will be studying and a homework project to complete by 13th June.



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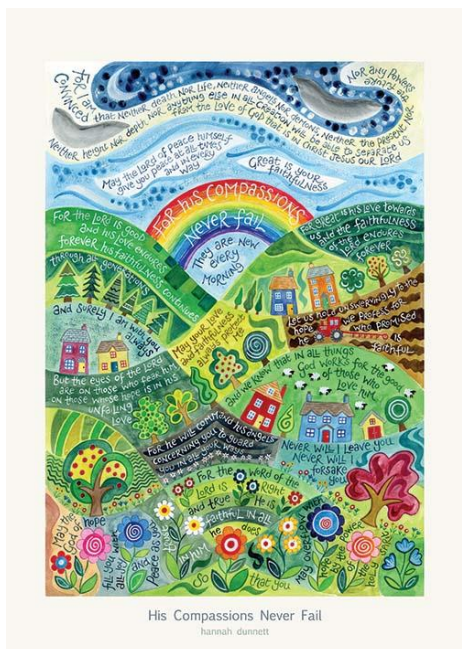
The art workshops will culminate in some permanent banners for the hall. Mrs Alexander will be running the sessions and would love some input from the Children.
